Include your first name, your last name and your seller number if you have sold within the last two sales. It is okay if you don't remember your number, we can look it up. Also include if you would like to volunteer. Shifts are listed below.

- If you signed up as a first time seller this past fall sale and didn't sell, you no longer have a seller number and will need to receive a new one by Email.
- If you are a previous seller but have not sold in the past two sales, you no longer have a seller number and will need to receive a new one by Email.
- If you sold in the past spring sale, you still must Email me and get a confirmation.

Every seller must get a confirmation Email from me (probably won't be immediate so please be patient) which will include your seller number and an **attachment of the instructions**.

There is no participation fee and sellers receive 70% of their sales from Kindermarket and the Home Furnishings sale. (You can just sell home furnishings if you don't have any children's items)

What are the shift responsibilities?

Setting up the sale will involve at least one of the following

- 1) Checking in items to make sure they are the appropriate season, look for non-consignment worthy items to give back to the seller, look at price tickets to make sure they were made correctly and are attached correctly.
- 2) Running checked items out to the appropriate areas of the sale and keeping the areas organized.

During the sale will involve at least one of the following

- 1) Taking tags off items for customers before they check out making sure all items are de-tagged.
- 2) Using a lap top to enter each ticket to total the sale. Taking the customer's money and making change. (we usually have our designated volunteers for this but sometimes need to ask for additional cashiers)
- 3) Walking the floor and straightening racks and making sure children are not opening packages as well as watching for suspicious activity to report to us. You are not responsible to approach anyone.

Breaking down the sale

- 1) Separating items by seller number. This shift is fast and furious and fun! We have this down to a science and would love to teach you how to do it. Wear comfortable shoes and get ready for a workout. Involves numbers and a lot of walking.

NEW THIS SALE: Please note that women's clothing will be donated. The volunteers will no longer separate and sort the women's clothing during break down. If you do not want your women's clothing donated, you may come at 3:30 on Saturday March 3rd and pick out your clothing. Also all women's clothing must be less than \$10 and it cannot be marked final sale (F/S). We are doing this in order to keep women's clothing in the sale.
