- 1. **Discipline Policy:** Our discipline policy is strict; we expect good behavior. Any child that continually distracts or creates an unsafe environment for themselves or others may be sent home. Cussing, inappropriate language or physical aggression results in a child being sent home.
 - a. Parents or guardians will be called if this happens and will need to pick up their child within 30 minutes of the call or the child is suspended the next program day they attend.
 - b. Recurring actions that result in a send home or suspension can be grounds for dismissal from programs.
- 2. **Illness policy:** Any child that appears to be sick will be sent home from youth programs. If your child or someone in your family is not feeling well, please stay home. If your child is sent home from school or stays home from school due to illness, they will be unable to check into youth programs.
- 3. **EMS/Paramedics:** In the event we feel the medical wellbeing of your child is at risk, we will call 911. If a parent or guardian is unable to arrive in time before EMS leaves the Y with their child, a director will ride with the child in the parent/guardian's place.
