

Our traffic system is designed to efficiently prevent back-up in Hawthrone Avenue and systematically check children out, call for them to leave and escort them to the vehicle. Our system operates as:

<u>Drop-off (2:50pm-3:40pm):</u>

- 1. Parents enter the loop from Hawthorne Avenue closest to our playground.
- 2. Parents pull through in the right-hand lane and let their children out along the curb.
- 3. Staff members will direct children into the building.
- 4. If you prefer to walk your child to the building, please park in the parking lot.

Pick-up (5:00pm-5:45pm):

- 1. Parents enter the loop from Hawthorne Avenue closest to our playground.
- 2. Parents need to have a pick-up pass or ID available during the checkout process.
 - a. An ID check requires us to check our registration system. This is timely, you will be directed to park and show your ID at the canopy (near the bulldog)
- 3. Parents will be directed by a staff labeled as "X "on the picture to either:
 - a. Check out your child with a staff member, standing at the "X," with an iPad and proceed to the right lane of the pickup loop.
 - b. Continue in the left-hand lane and wrap around to the other side of the loop to meet a staff member, labeled as "O", with an iPad to check-out their child. You will then proceed with traffic around the loop. Please show your pass to the next available staff member to call for your child.
 - c. Stop and wait to be directed to the lefthand lane or the righthand lane.
- 4. Parents/rides should continue moving forward as traffic moves. Please do not park in the loop unless there is a vehicle in front of you.

Check-out and Pick-up courtesy:

- 1. Our system relies on vehicles moving in and out quickly and efficiently, please move when directed by staff.
- 2. Please do not exit your vehicle at any time while in the pick-up loop.
 - a. Staff escort every child to the vehicle.
- 3. If you need to fasten a seat belt, please allow us to escort your child to the car and then move to the parking lot to fasten them in.
- 4. If your windows are tinted, please roll them down in order for us to read the card you are showing.
- 5. Children move slowly (they're busy socializing), may not hear their name or may be in the bathroom. If you have been waiting for a period that seems abnormal, please ask us to call again!
